WJHS TECHNOLOGY ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY

The use of technology equipment (networks, computers, cameras, software, etc.) is important to the success of WJHS students. Therefore, tampering, unauthorized use of computers, unauthorized copying/installation of programs, or "hacking" may cause students to lose access to technology equipment. Please be aware of the following rules.

1. *No defacing of desks, tables, chairs, keyboards, machines, mice, or any other equipment in any way.*
2. *No unauthorized use of equipment. Permission must be granted for students to use computers before, during, or after school and/or for non-class applications.*
3. *No copying of any school software programs without special permission from the school administration.*
4. *No changing or tampering with a teacher's password or files.*
5. *No access to network programs without proper approval from WJHS teachers or administration.*
6. *No "hacking" in the network operating system.*

Subsequent to any of the offenses listed, and those which are later imposed, access to WJHS computers and the student computer network may be suspended or revoked and the student may be removed with a failing grade from any class in which Williamsville Jr. High computers are used. In addition, students may be disciplined for any such problems according to the guidelines in the Williamsville Jr. High School student handbook, including restitution for any damage done.

In keeping with the Williamsville School District Technology Plan, the Internet is one of the tools used in the education of our students. Using the latest safeguards and the specific direction of teachers, WJHS students have the opportunity to access information on the Internet.

Every precaution will be taken to insure positive uses for the Internet. Inappropriate use of the Internet by students will be disciplined under the same terms as listed above.
